AL JARREAU

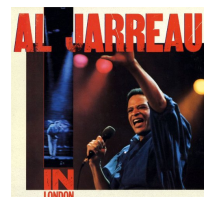
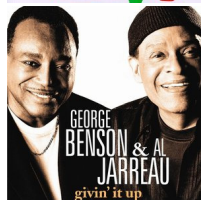
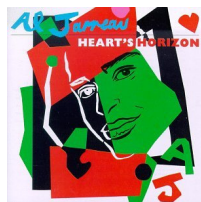
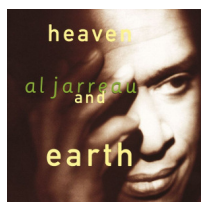
12 March 1940 –
Milwaukee, Wisconsin



The only vocalist in history to win Grammy Awards® in three different categories (Jazz, Pop, and R&B, respectively), Al Jarreau was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on March 12, 1940. The fifth child of a Seventh-day Adventist Church vicar and pianist mother, he and his family sang together in church concerts and benefits. After receiving an undergraduate degree in psychology and his master's degree in vocational rehabilitation, Jarreau pursued a career as a rehabilitation counselor in San Francisco. While there, he “moonlighted” with a jazz trio headed by George Duke.

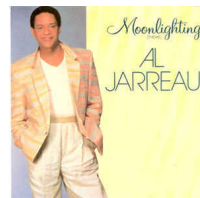

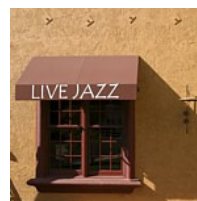
