Al Alvarado

Havana, Cuba . 1959

His family escaped Cuba during the Castro revolution. They first fled to Jamaica and after securing visas in 1961, landed at New York's JFK airport.

They moved to a southern New Jersey town where Al grew up. He started playing alto sax in the 4th grade on an old Bundy, one he gigged on until 1981.

In 1977 he entered the US Air Force, then married and raised his own family, retiring as a Master Sergeant in 1996. Alvarado focused his attention on being a

professional musician, developing his reputation as a "first call" player. Al spent 21 years with the regionally-renowned band Jones & Company. Some of his awards include the *Best of Show* Air Force Worldwide Talent Competition, *Best Horn Player* Beachcomber Music Awards (2011) and for 3 consecutive years, the *Best of the Emerald Coast*.
