The Mobile Arts Council received 19 applications from its membership base of arts organizations, crafters, graphic designers, photographers, musicians, theaters, visual artists, and videographers for its 2017 Arts Grants. A panel of professional artists and arts educators selected four recipients for the awards. Mystic Order of the Jazz Obsessed was chosen to receive a \$1000 grant.

We will use the grant to continue our commitment to promote jazz education for young people. This award will fund a collaborative project with the Mobile Public Library's 2017 *Build a Better World* Summer Library Program. Over 500 children, ages 6-13, are expected to attend

the summer program finale on Saturday, July 29th, 10am-1pm at the Ben May Main Library.

JazZooLA: Build a Better World with Jazz, includes a 45-minute Excelsior Band concert, followed by a "jazz instrument zoo" educational component and drawings for gift cards for books for program participants.



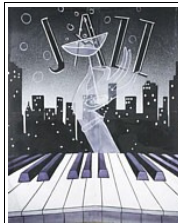
