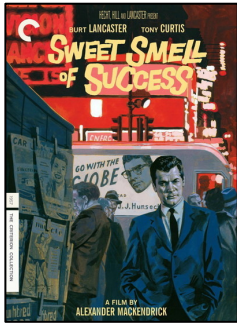

Q. Best jazz noir movie?



A. *Probably Sweet Smell of Success, from 1957. It stars Tony Curtis and Burt Lancaster. It's about power, manipulation and betrayal. It has great acting, perfect noir cinematography, a fantastic screenplay and the soundtrack is courtesy of Elmer Bernstein and Chico Hamilton. It's set in New York City during an era when small jazz clubs*

were still common and teenybopper culture hadn't yet assumed control.

Q. First jazz album?

A. *I don't even recall the name of it but it was one of numerous anthologies of Charlie Parker "hits" found in a bargain bin at Peaches Records.*



Q. Favorite jazz instrument?

A. *Technically, there's no such thing as a "jazz instrument" since you can play jazz on any instrument.*

Q. What musical talent would you like to have?

A. *To play the things I hear in my head.*

Q. Future of jazz?

A. *That's impossible for me to say. I like Matthew Shipp's folding of contemporary elements into the genre and the implementation of contemporary pop canon without sacrificing exploration.*
