Q. Best jazz noir movie?



A. Probably Sweet Smell of Success, from 1957. It stars Tony Curtis and Burt Lancaster. It's about power, manipulation and betrayal. It has great acting, perfect noir cinematography, a fantastic screenplay and the soundtrack is courtesy of Elmer Bernstein and Chico Hamilton. It's set in New York City during an era when small jazz clubs

were still common and teenybopper culture hadn't yet assumed control.

Q. First jazz album?

A. I don't even recall the name of it but it was one of numerous anthologies of Charlie Parker "hits" found in a bargain bin at Peaches Records.



A. Technically, there's no such thing as a "jazz instrument" since you can play jazz on any instrument.

Q. What musical talent would you like to have?

A. To play the things I hear in my head.

Q. Future of jazz?

A. That's impossible for me to say. I like Matthew Shipp's folding of contemporary elements into the genre and the implementation of contemporary pop canon without sacrificing exploration.
