roman street

Brothers Noah and Josh Thompson came together in 2006 to form Roman Street. What started as a friendly jam session has developed into the Billboard/iTunes charting band who many have dubbed "the next generation" of jazz fusion. Roman Street was named for an old street in the Alps.



They are internationally-trained and specialize in improvisational fusion of classical, Gypsy and contemporary jazz, Latin, and Nuevo Flamenco. A departure from the over-produced music of today, Roman Street keeps it simple- the

beautifully organic sound of acoustic instruments played by talented people who love what they are doing.

Opening concerts for international sensations George Benson, Boney James, The Rippingtons, Earl Klugh, Jesse Cook, and the Preservation Hall Jazz Band. Roman Street is a regular at jazz festivals and annual trips to Europe. Their music has found its way to over 20 countries around the world.



Roman Street has expanded its sound to include additional musicians and continues to grow. Another set of brothers, Brian (drums) and Jojo Morris (bass), join them tonight.

"When brothers Joshua and Noah, and their full band made their Catalina Island JazzTrax Festival debut October 2013 we were blown away. They outsold ALL other bands' CDs at the JazzTrax store... So full band, or dueling duo, I would suggest Roman Street for any jazz or music festival since their sound goes far beyond just smooth jazz."
