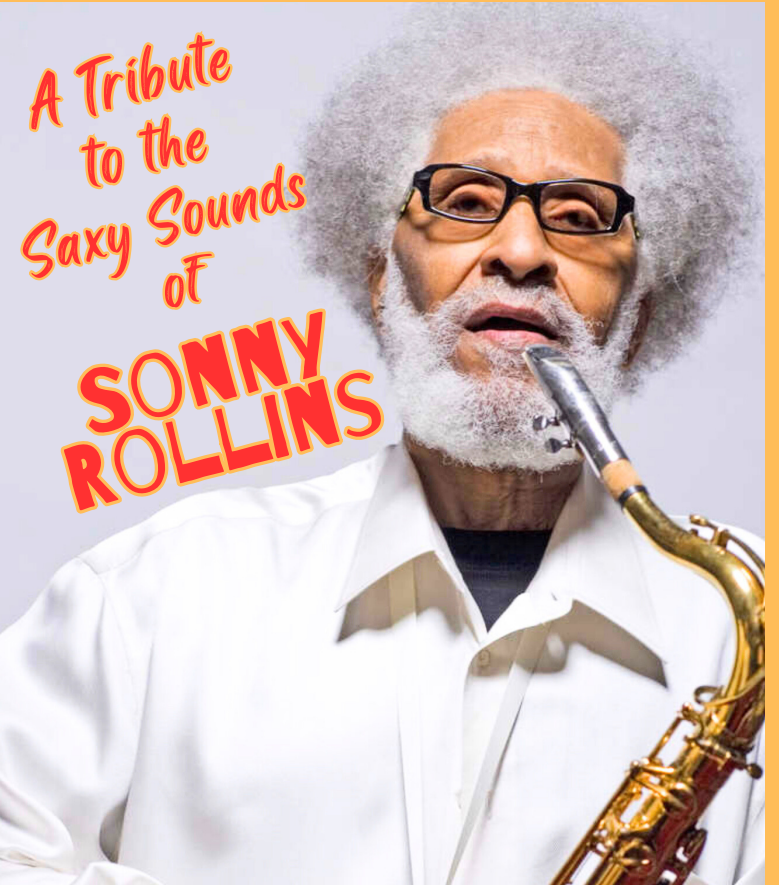

ABOUT TONIGHT'S PERFORMANCE....

MOJO proudly presents a tribute to the music of one of jazz's most influential living legends. Rebecca Barry and Friends will lead us on a journey through some of Rollins' most popular compositions. Born in Fairhope, AL, Rebecca received both academic and musical scholarships after her graduation from the local high school. Still, she didn't know how to improvise, but that problem was solved in her studies at Loyola with Tony Dagradi who introduced her to the music of Sonny Rollins, Dexter Gordon, Lester Young and John Coltrane.

Studying in New Orleans, she was graduated from Loyola University and then received her masters in jazz studies from the University of New Orleans where she studied with Ellis Marsalis and saxophonist Ed Peterson. After graduation, she embarked on a musical career playing with Kermit Ruffins, Little Queenie Harris and Lou Rawls and became a regular in the French Quarter jazz scene. She has recorded several CDs, some containing her own compositions, and has performed with groups all over Europe and Latin America.

Presently teaching music at Coastal Alabama Community College, Rebecca credits her love of the art form to her middle school band director and another teacher who taught her to play saxophone. Back home in Alabama now, she plays at The Cigar Bar in Daphne on Thursdays from 6-10 PM and all over the Central Gulf Coast region.

Walter Theodore "Sonny" Rollins, born September 7, 1930, is an American jazz tenor saxophonist who is widely recognized as one of the most important and influential jazz musicians. In a seven-decade career, he has recorded over sixty albums as a leader. A number of his compositions, including "St. Thomas", "Oleo", "Doxy", and "Airegin", have become jazz standards. Rollins has been called "the greatest living improviser"!
