ABOUT TONIGHT'S PERFORMANCE...

The Joe Cool Trio will present interpretations of composer Vince Guaraldi's "Charlie Brown Christmas" soundtrack, songs the trio performs on the Saenger Theatre's more expansive stage every December for the last 13 years.

The trio holds the best regional jazz talents to be found. Drummer John Milham has built a reputation for being as nice as he is talented, and he attended internationally famous Berklee. In his three decades performing, he has gathered plaudits across the region. Pianist Chris Spies has thrilled regional audiences for roughly as long, performing across the western hemisphere, often in collaboration with Milham. New Orleans-based bassist Chris Severin is mentioned as top of the art in the Crescent City, having performed with Dianne Reeves, Terrance Blanchard, the Marsalis family, Irma Thomas, Nicholas Payton, and Lou Rawls.

The ensemble will perform Guaraldi's widely popular Christmas works and other compositions by the San Francisco pianist. The jazz musician already had a Grammy Award before he shot to public awareness on the heels of his work for the CBS animation special. The idea of witnessing talent on this level in such a personal setting is rare. To do so for such a low price is startling. Keep your MOJO workin'!
