## ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE

**BILL COLEMAN & FRIENDS** will pay tribute to the legendary **Wes Montgomery!** Acclaimed as one of the most influential jazz guitarists in recent history, Montgomery was known for his unusual technique of plucking the strings with the side of his thumb and for his extensive use of octaves, which gave him a distinctive sound. Montgomery's recordings up to 1965 were oriented toward hard bop, soul jazz, and post bop, but around 1965 he began recording more pop-oriented instrumental albums that found mainstream success. His later guitar style influenced jazz fusion and smooth jazz.

Popular local guitarist, **Bill Coleman**, along with drummer **Warren Wilson** and bassist **Dave Wells**, will honor **Montgomery's** musical legacy!
